SHOOTING AT HAZELWICK SCHOOL

In order for everyone to be able to shoot in a safe and enjoyable environment, please make sure you abide by the following

- Read the club rules and adhere to these
- All carbon arrows are not allowed
- Do have fun, but please be aware of your audience
- Check your equipment before shooting to ensure it is set up properly, or ask a fellow archer to help you with this
- Help set up and take down equipment (its never fun if you are the one always doing this).
- If you require a specific target/distance to be set up, make sure to arrive as early as possible to help set this up
- Talk to your fellow archers and agree between yourselves what targets to set up
- Talk to your fellow archers at the end of the session to make sure enough people around to help pack away
- Avoid over loading the trailer
- Take care when operating the tractor and trailer – its not a toy!
- Pack away the equipment carefully so as not to cause damage (they get enough wear and tear as it is!)
- If something does get broken, report it to the equipment officer or a committee member so a repair may be arranged
- Don't use damaged equipment
- Take your rubbish with you
- If a target face has been shot out, remove it and dispose of it (but they are not recyclable!), or keep it as a souvenir
- Respect the coaches if they wish to shoot separately (they are volunteers and still like to shoot a few arrows)
- Refrain from shooting at a short distance with a high impact bow, otherwise you may damage something!
- Obey the whistle commands of the field captain at all times
- Log any lost arrows in the book held in the shed
